

# Popsicle Block

Required fabric:

## Popsicle body:

(12) 1.5 X 4 various shades/patterns for popsicle

(8) 1.5x 1.5 squares of background fabric (A)

## Popsicle stick:

(4) 1.5 x 2.5 stick fabric (B)

## Background fabrics:

(8) 2 x 2 background fabric (F)

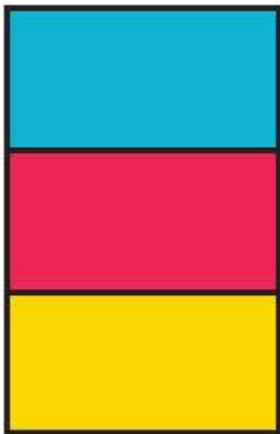
(5) 1.5 x 12 strips of background fabric outside edges (C)

(2) 1.5 x 6.5 of background fabric (D)

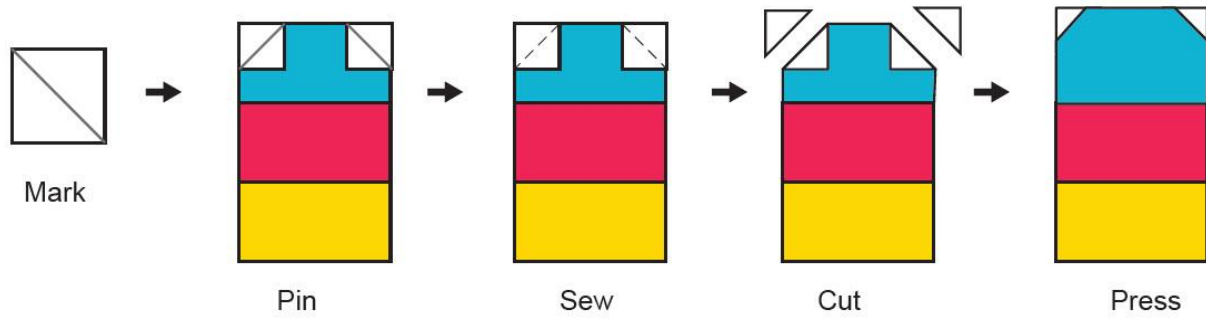
(8) 1.75 x 2.25 fabric (E)

## Step 1:

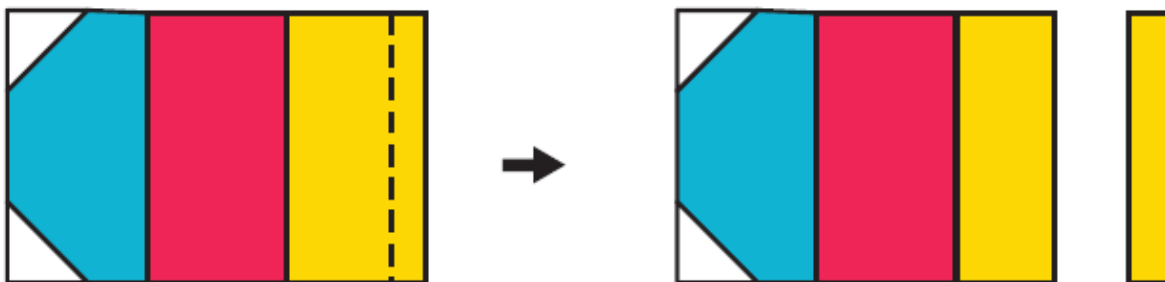
Sew 3 popsicle rectangles (1.5x 4) with right sides together with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.



Next, take two of your 1.5" fabric A squares and mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side. Place them right side down on the two upper corners of your popsicle. Sew across your marked line. Cut off the excess 1/4" away from your sewn line, and then open and press.

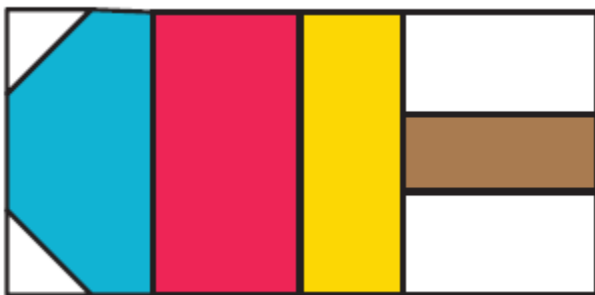


Trim 1" off the bottom of your popsicle.



## Step 2

To create the popsicle stick, sew background fabric 1.75 x 2.25 fabric (E) to either side of the stick fabric 1.5 x 2.5 stick fabric (B) Make 4 of these

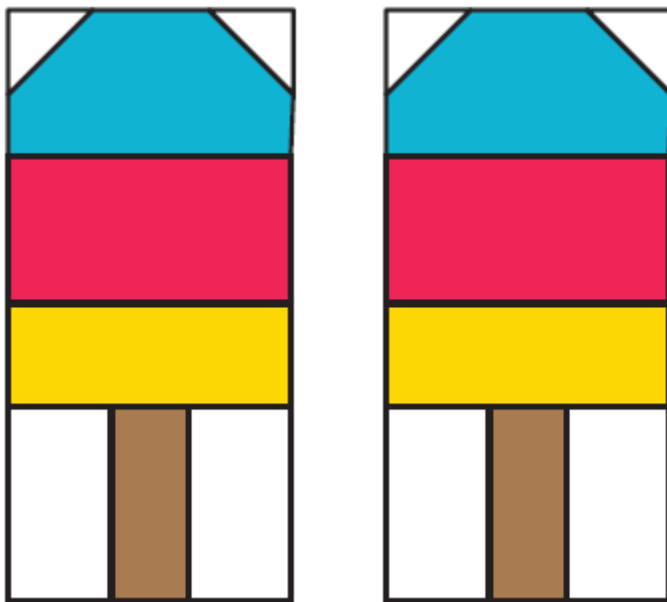
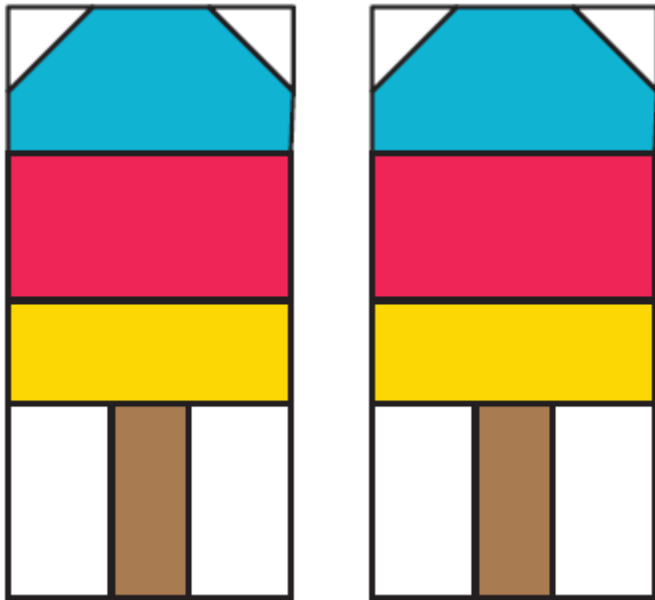


### Step 3

Sew 1.5 x 6.5 of background fabric (D) to the bottom of two of the popsicles

Sew the two top popsicles to the bottom popsicles.

Sew 1.5 x 12 strips of background fabric (C) outside edges and in the center of the two popsicles



Trim block to 12x12
