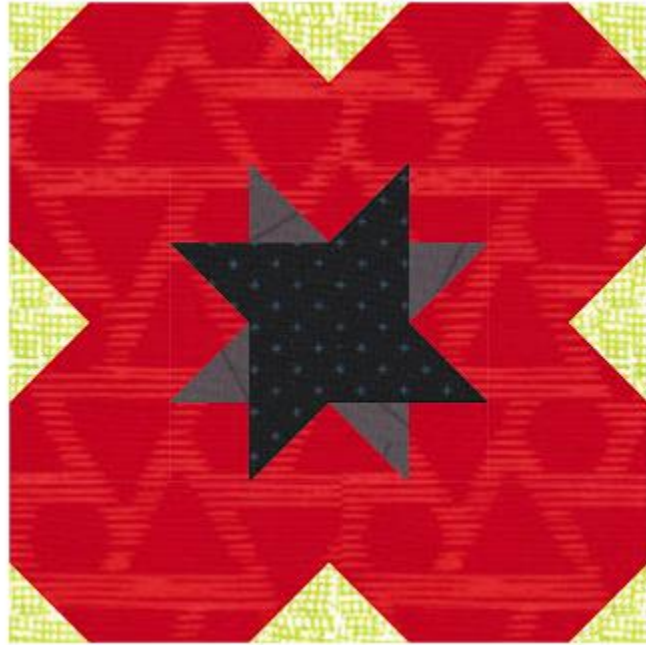


Poppy Flower Quilt Block



Fabric A (background):

- (4) 1 1/2" sq. (*)
- (4) 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" (**)

Fabric B (red petals):

- (8) 1 1/2" sq. (*)
- (4) 2 1/2" sq.
- (4) 3 1/2" sq.

Fabric C (black center):

- (4) 1 1/2" sq. (*)
- (1) 2 1/2" sq.

Fabric D (dark gray center):

- (4) 1 1/2" sq. (*)

Double Upper Corners

1. Place a square at the left end or left upper corner of a rectangle or larger square, right sides together.
2. Stitch from right upper to left lower corner.
3. Clip, flip & press.
4. Place a square at the right end or right upper corner of a rectangle or larger square, right sides together.
5. Stitch from left upper corner to right lower corner.
6. Clip, flip & press.

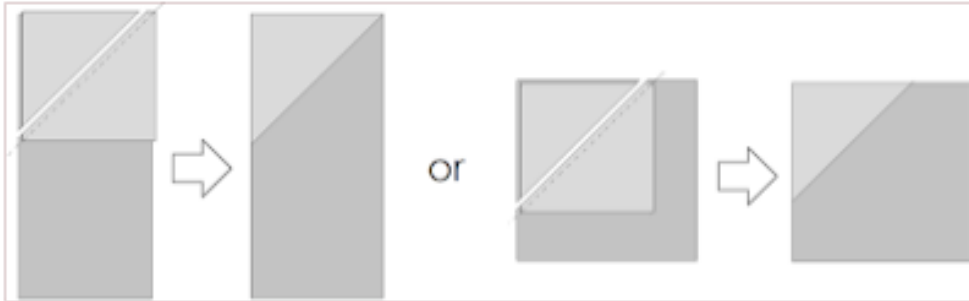


*Using above method, (2) 1 1/2" sq. of Fabric B and 1 1/2 x 2 1/2" rect. of Fabric A, make one unit. Be sure to trim, flip and press the first corner before stitching the second corner. You're basically making a flying geese unit. **REPEAT for total of four** of these units.

*Using the same steps, 1 1/2" sq. of Fabric C-left upper corner, 1 1/2" sq. of Fabric D-right upper corner, and 2 1/2" sq. of Fabric B, make one unit. **REPEAT for total of four** of these units.

Left Upper Clip & Flip

1. Place square at upper end or left upper corner of rectangle or larger square, right sides together.
2. Stitch from right upper to left lower corner.
3. Clip, flip & press.



*Using the above method, 1 1/2" sq. of Fabric A and 3 1/2" sq. of Fabric B, make one unit. **REPEAT for total of four** of these units.

Assemble poppy block as shown below using [scant quarter inch seams](#). Block will be 8 1/2" sq. at this point, 8" when finished in quilt.
